### Quick Facts

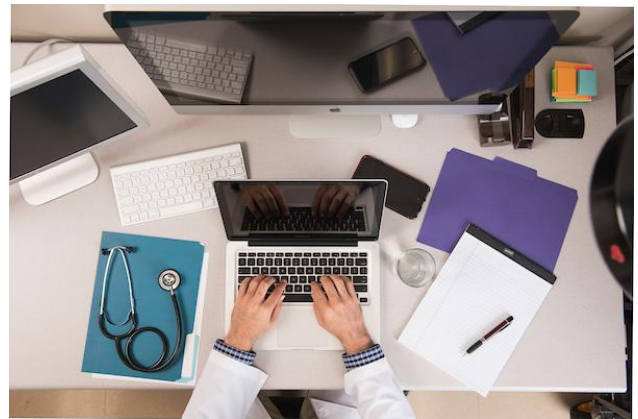
- MS program is condensed to 12 months
